PROCLAMATION

Recognition of the Dedicated Career of Norma Eliza Cantu

- Whereas,* Norma Eliza Cantu “Lisa” was born on January 21, 1968, to Mr. and Mrs. Oscar M. and Josefina Cantu (both still living—PSJA Graduates, 1962) and grew up with brothers Oscar M. Cantu, Jr., and JC Cantu.
- Whereas,* Ms. Cantu has two daughters, Alexa Monique and Annalysa Marie, both of whom graduated from PSJA, and has one grandson, CJ; and
- Whereas,* Ms. Cantu, in her early childhood, attended Sorensen and Doedyns Elementary, Austin Jr. High School, and graduated in 1986 from PSJA High School, where she was a cheerleader, Rotary Couple with Russell Beamsley, and Homecoming Queen; and
- Whereas,* In December of 1992, she graduated from UTPA with a degree in interdisciplinary studies; and
- Whereas,* she began her teaching career in December 1992 as a sixth-grade science teacher at LBJ Middle School. In August 2000, she relocated to San Juan Middle School, where she taught eighth-grade history and sixth-grade science; and
- Whereas,* In August of 2008, she moved to PSJA High School to teach US history; subsequently, she has also taught World Geography, World History, Special Education Inclusion, Teen Leadership, and Powerlifting; and
- Whereas,* Ms. Cantu has been a senior class sponsor since 2012, a head coach for cheering since 2012, and a head coach for powerlifting since 2018; and
- Whereas,* in addition to many state qualifiers, Ms. Cantu has coached multiple Bear Spirit Awards Cheerleading Teams and coached a Powerlifting State Champion; and
